See 'Secret Cinema' preview, films by female animators, or compete to finish film in 48 hours

"Womanimation!" a celebration of women in animation, returns to AS220 at 95 Empire St., Providence, on June 28.

The festival is now in its sixth year. This year's program is diverse in its themes, animated styles and geography, with 11 films from 10 countries. Ten of the films will be having their U.S. premieres.

The films include a Czech re-imagining of Greek legend, "Mythopolis," with Medusa as a struggling single mom; "Wedding Cake" from Germany, in which two figurines on top of a wedding cake have their own marital problems; and "The Role of Each Fret" from Iran, in which cutout Persian miniatures tell the story of couple in love trying to reunite.

Screenings are at 5, 7, and 9 p.m. (In addition to the films, there will also be music.) Admission is \$10.
